

WHAT TO BRING?

The following is a list of items that the youth of your group should and should not bring on their trip to The Campbell Farm. We prefer that they not bring any electronic items so that they can truly hear the farm sounds, and be involved with the people they meet here on the Res.

Items to bring:

Closed toe work shoes and socks
Flashlight
Bible
Pen (We will provide a journaling notebook)
Sunscreen
Bug Repellant
Sleeping bag or bedding (it does get hot)
Toiletries
Water bottle
Swim Suit (one piece)
Towel(s)
Comfortable clothing/& Clothing to paint in and get dirty!
Frisbee and other recreation equipment
(We do have basketballs, volleyballs, baseballs & bats)
Alarm Clocks for leaders
Old shoes for floating the river (no flip-flops)

Items NOT to bring:

Cigarettes
Alcohol or drugs
Walkman, Radios, etc. (no electronics)
Weapons of any kind
Video games
No cell phones except for leaders
